At our Archdiocesan Assembly, we heard about a project called **CONNECTIONS**, which looks to partner needy organizations or people in Albania with donors from America.

Natural Church Development

At our last Parish Meeting, we agreed to begin the **Natural Church Development (NCD)** program, under the guidance of Fr. Jonathan Ivanoff, secretary of the Orthodox Church in America's Department of Evangelization.

Under the program, the health of our parish will be assessed on the basis of eight "Quality Characteristics": *Empowering Leadership, Gift-based Ministry, Fervent Spirituality, Effective Structures, Inspiring Worship, Holistic Fellowship Groups, Need-oriented Evangelism, and Loving Relationships*. The lowest scoring characteristic is known as the "Minimum Factor."

Father Jonathan will be here on Saturday, November 12th, to conduct an orientation workshop for our **Church Health Team**. This team is a small group of our parishioners who will direct the actual NCD program in the parish. Some of the responsibilities of the team will be to:

- Select parishioners to take the NCD survey.
- Conduct focus groups— small groups of parishioners who meet informally and discuss why a particular aspect of parish life is the "Minimum Factor" and what can be done about it.
- Compile the data collected from the focus groups and prepare an "Action Plan" which focuses on improving the "Minimum Factor."

We need 5 to 7 volunteers to be on the **Church Health Team**. If you would like to participate, please speak to Father Dennis or Laura Chadwick.
